SUMMARY OF EXAM COURSE

1. COLLECTION OF WORK- 40% (dictionary allowed)

- Comprised of **at least 8** assignments- 4 reading and 4 writing
- Can be a collection of the students' best work

All assignments to have cover sheet.

AURAL EXAMINATION-30% (no dictionary allowed) The listening activity will be scheduled at a specific time.

- 1 listening activity of around 15 minutes duration-can use any listening material including Total English book/exam past papers.
- Students have to answer 5 questions of 6 marks each. Tape is played three times.(2x15 minutes)

Transcripts can be any listening activities e.g from Total English/recorded news reports/or past papers

TRANSCRIPT REQUIRED AS EVIDENCE WITH COVER SHEET IN STUDENT PORTFOLIO.

2. SKILLS DEMONSTRATION-(speaking exam) 30% (no dictionary allowed)

The SPEAKING exam will be scheduled at a specific time.

CANDIDATES HAVE TO:

- Talk about themselves, family, education and work in an interview context.
- Participate in a dialogue set in a work/social context

EVIDENCE OF THIS INTERVIEW CAN INCLUDE:

- Audio/visual
- CV
- Documents/list of questions
- Role play situations

With a **witness statement** signed by the teacher OR **audio/visual proof**
INTERVIEW AND DIALOGUE TO BE AT LEAST 10 MINUTES IN DURATION
AND CANDIDATES MAY BE GIVEN 10 MINUTES TO PREPARE.
